

EARNING OF CREDIT

Students can earn course credit by demonstrating mastery of the required coursework and material. Mastery is defined as a student presenting sufficient evidence of attainment of the required competencies.

Student assessment of mastery is the responsibility of the building principal.

Credit will be awarded upon a student's ability to demonstrate learning in compliance with the district-specified curriculum and assessment standards. This includes satisfactory demonstration and mastery of the required course competencies.
