Small, achievable goals that your student can reach in the short term will go a long way in building your student's confidence and sense of accomplishment. Even starting out with daily or weekly goals is a wonderful way to help your student begin to learn the importance of goal setting.

Our PBIS Character Theme of the Month is gratitude. I am grateful for all the members of our school community, including our MVMS staff and students. The MVMS staff work each day to help our students to grow and find academic, social, and behavioral success. Thank you all for your dedication and support of MVMS.

As a reminder, students may not be dropped off at MVMS prior to 7:45 a.m. If students arrive @ 7:45, they must use a pass to access the library. Regular dropoff time is 8:00, and students should report to their assigned area. Students arriving after 8:40 are marked late. Arriving at school on time is important to give your student the best possible start to their day.

Arriving at school after classes have begun can cause students to miss more than just the introduction to a new lesson. Teachers often share valuable information: reminders of upcoming quizzes, class trips, new classroom rules, essay due dates and other school-related specifics. Students who show up late may miss these details and be unprepared for future class events. While a teacher will likely reiterate crucial information throughout the day, latecomers may miss courtesy reminders about homework assignments and other projects. >>> SCHOOL NURSE UPDATE

As we go into the winter months, please be aware we are continuing to see an increase in illness at school. Strep throat, Influenza, and COVID-19 are still occurring with regular frequency as are other respiratory and gastrointestinal illnesses. If you child presents with any potential symptoms such as cough, congestion, sore throat, headache, fever, extreme fatigue, diarrhea, or vomiting, please keep them home and call the MVMS nurses for guidance. Students should not be coming to school within 24 hours of any episode of vomiting or diarrhea and must be fever free off any medication for 24 hours before returning to school. The absence of a fever does not rule out contagious illnesses and if you suspect Strep throat, Influenza, or COVID-19, please call your child's PCP or access Urgent Care for an evaluation. Home testing for COVID-19 is still recommended for any COVID-19 symptoms and especially if there has been a known contact. If your child tests positive for COVID-19, keep them home and contact the MVMS nurses for guidance. The MVMS nurses serve as a resource for families as they navigate these and other illnesses, please call us with any questions or concerns, we are happy to help.

It is that time of year when team 8-2 fundraises for the Veterans of Liberty House. This has been a proud event for many years at MVMS. Money collected over January and February will be donated to the veterans living at Liberty House in Manchester. You are able to read all about this organization at www.LibertyHouseNH.Org. For a long time, this organization has "provided a safe, supportive, substance-free housing community for American veterans transitioning out of homelessness. 
